Bible Study Skills, in the Summer, Pastor Brad?! Well...it seems a bit aggressive, but 'nothing ventured, nothing gained'! #1 Question: will there be homework? #1 Answer: this is a challenge-by-choice course. Nobody has to do the homework. However, in-class discussion will be weighted in favor of those students who complete the homework prior to class. Students will gain an understanding of the nature of the Scriptures and learn to study the text on their own, drawing Biblical conclusions and making personal applications. Required Texts: NIV Bible (1984, preferred), & "Studying, Interpreting and Applying the Bible" by Walter Henrichsen and Gayle Jackson (available used for \$6 and up from Amazon).
