ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Becoming a Lifelong Disciple: Becoming a Lifelong Disciple is a weekly training workshop in relational skills that enable believers to share their faith with family, friends, neighbors and co-workers in a relaxed, informal, conversational way. This is especially helpful in sharing with those who are indifferent or maybe even hostile to Christian faith. Rather than written lessons or lectures, participants learn through practical exercises, combined with role play using real conversations they've had in the past. Becoming a Lifelong Disciple is a 26-week or two quarter class which begins September 11 and will end on February 26. **Led by Pastor Brant, Kitty Vacha, and others in the church Library.**

Hope in the Present: We will look at current events and how God is moving today in our very midst. This is not a look at prophetic passages but finding the very hope and promises God provides us in the very present. He is always good, let's lean into Him. **Led by Aaron Noler in Room 107.**
